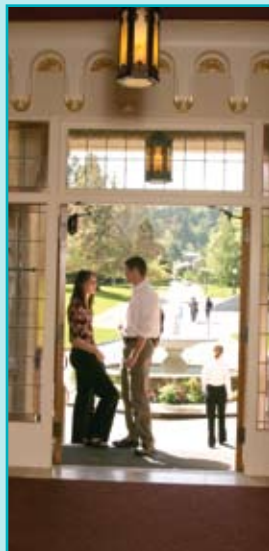

ENGLISH PROFICIENCY REQUIREMENTS

for admission to Marylhurst University

Students who want to attend Marylhurst University have different admission options as determined by English ability or test scores.

DIRECT ADMISSION TO MARYLHURST UNIVERSITY

Students qualify for admission to Marylhurst undergraduate and graduate programs with a score of:

- 79 or higher on the internet-based TOEFL (iBT)
- 77 or higher on the Michigan English Language Assessment Battery (MELAB)
- 6.5 or higher on the International English Language Testing System (IELTS)

ADMISSION TO FOUNDATION PROGRAMS

Students with a score between 64 to 78 on the iBT, 68 to 76 on the MELAB, or 6-6.4 on the IELTS may choose one of the following options.

Undergraduate Foundation Program – Provides students with additional writing support while they are enrolled in undergraduate studies at Marylhurst University.

Pathways to Success – Prepares students for Marylhurst's MBA program with classes emphasizing research, communication, writing and business practices.

ADMISSION TO ENGLISH LANGUAGE PROGRAM

Students *without* a TOEFL score, or a score *less than 64* on the iBT, may enroll at **Pacific International Academy (PIA)** for intensive English language training.

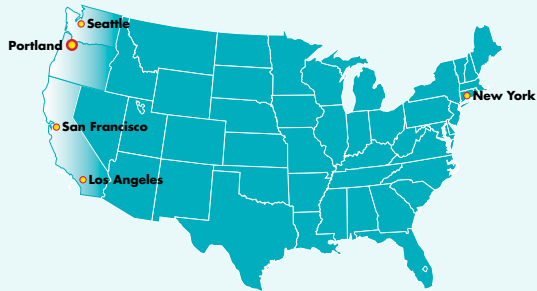
- Five levels of intensive ESL
