Completed forms should be returned to the Financial Aid Office.

If your financial aid exceeds your tuition charges, the excess will be paid to you in the form of a check issued by the Student Accounts Office for the purpose of meeting other education costs such as books, living expenses, and transportation to and from classes.

If your financial aid does not cover the full amount of tuition charges, you will need to make arrangements with the Student Accounts Office for payment of the balance due in order to ensure that your registration is complete and you are enrolled in your classes.
